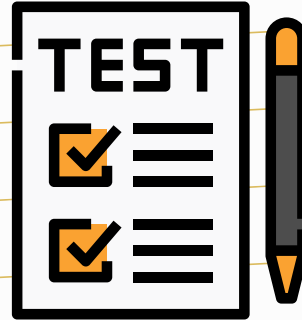

# Special Education

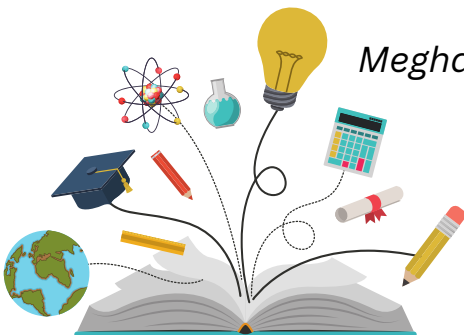


Believe it or not, the end of the school year is fast approaching. The special education team is very busy with end-of-the-year tasks. If you have a 5th-grade student who receives special education services, Mrs. Roberts or Mrs. Levesque will be reaching out to you to set up transition meetings for the middle school. You will be able to meet the case manager at WLC and learn more about how your child's day will look. If you have a kindergarten student, Mrs. Dailey will be meeting with you at FRES.

Another end of the year task is planning for Extended School Year (ESY). The case managers will send a list of students to the SAU and the special education department will send home forms to those students to invite them to ESY. Students going into 6th grade will have ESY at WLC. This will give them an introduction to middle school. The FRES and WLC ESY will run from July 1st to July 31st. It will only meet Tuesday through Thursday from 8:00-11:30. There will be a program for the FRES RISE students which will run Monday through Thursday from June 30th to August 7th from 8:00-2:30. The purpose of ESY is to practice skills already learned in reading and math to keep the skills fresh and in memory during extended breaks of time.
