Description

The WLC Educators Scholarship is a scholarship designed by educators for a deserving WLC student. All WLC employees will have the opportunity to pay \$30 a year or \$1 a week to wear jeans on Fridays for the school year. This scholarship will provide educators with an opportunity to give back to their community in a fun and creative way!

Eligibility Criteria

The WLC Educators Scholarship provides scholarship assistance to Wilton-Lyndeborough Cooperative High School students who are interested in pursuing higher education.

To be considered for this scholarship, you must:

- 1. Be a WLC high school student
- 2. Be accepted to a part-time or full-time university or college or trade school
- 3. Complete the WLC Educators Scholarship essay

Selection Process

The Scholarship Committee, made up of the school counseling department and administration will consider these criteria in making their selection:

- 1. Academic achievement
- 2. Financial need
- 3. Letter of recommendation from a teacher
- 4. Statement of educational goals and career objectives
- 5. WLC Educators Scholarship essay

Deadline to Apply

This is a Local Scholarship Application and therefore must be handed in by Monday, March 20, 2017. Applications received after the Monday, March 20, 2017 deadline will not be considered.

Method of Disbursement

Award(s) are paid in one installment(s) and given directly to the student at WLC Awards Night.













Scholarship Duration

One time scholarship opportunity.

Revocation of Scholarship

This scholarship may be revoked by the founders of the SAU 63 Educators Scholarship for any of the following reasons:

- 1. Students placed on academic probation by the Wilton-Lyndeborough High School administration
- 2. Students suspended from school
- 3. Any act of misconduct which would bring discredit to the image of the scholarship is subject to review by the founders of the SAU63 Educators Scholarship and possible revocation.
